Conditions of Entry – Fire Engine & Vintage Vehicle Show 24 & 25 June 2017

- 1. Entries are accepted at the discretion of the organisers.
- 2. The organisers reserve the right to combine, cancel or sub-divide classes should the level of entries so determine. Entries falling outside these classes may be displayed, but may not be judged. Late entries may also not be judged and exhibitors turning up on the day of the event may be subject to a late entry fee.
- 3. Exhibitors should check in to the Control tent between 9.00 and 10.30am where you will be given your official entry number. The general public will be admitted from 11am until 5pm.
- 4. Judging will take place on Sunday 25 June between 11am and 3pm. Exhibits must be positioned displaying your number and be accompanied by the exhibitor. Awards will be presented from approximately 4.30pm in the Arena.
- 5. If your exhibit has appeared on T.V. or in films and you wish it to be included in Class Z, please indicate so in the section below. Inclusion in this section will not prevent your exhibit from being displayed/judged with the rest of its normal class(es).
- 6. Static machinery exhibits must be in working order, presented in a clean and safe condition, and it is the **exhibitor's responsibility** to ensure that the exhibit is safe for public viewing.
- 7. All exhibits must be insured against third party risk and, where applicable, licensed and tested. No engines are to be left running on unattended exhibits, and all parked exhibits must be securely braked/chocked. Steam entries must have and display a current boiler certificate and valid insurance. **Note that once sited, exhibits will not be moved until the close of the event each day.**
- 8. **All exhibits are displayed at the owner's risk**, the organisers can and will accept no liability for any loss of or damage to any exhibit on the show field.
- 9. Access to the Campsite will be limited to exhibitors only, and plots must be booked in advance. Campers must not pitch camp until after checking in to the Control tent, to ensure they do not camp in a restricted area. You will be directed to your pitch after positioning your exhibit. Please read carefully the conditions which apply to campers, which will be on the reverse of your camping permit.
- 10. Any enquiries for trade/craft/charity or auto-jumble stalls should be made to the Council. Enquiries for stalls selling fire brigade charity related items should be made to Brett Clayton of TAFER. NO stalls will be permitted to sell any food or drink without the express permission of the organisers.
- 11.All vehicles MUST restrict their speed to a maximum of 5 mph throughout the Park. Exhibitors should at all times conduct themselves in a manner which will cause neither inconvenience nor annoyance to either the general public or fellow exhibitors. Please note all restrictions as laid down by the Road Traffic Acts apply to the Park. Any exhibitor found to be ignoring the Conditions of Entry will be excluded from the event. The use of gopeds and similar modes of transport on the site is expressly prohibited. Cycling on the showground is prohibited during Show opening hours.
- 12. ALL DOGS MUST BE HELD ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES, owners must clear up after their dogs.
